## **REVIEW OF NON CONTENTIOUS BUSINESS DETERMINATIONS**

Thank you for your letter of 28 October 2022, giving notice that the Legal Profession (Non-contentious Probate Costs) Determination 2021, Legal Profession (Public Notaries) Determination 2021, and the Legal Profession (Solicitors Costs) Determination 2021 (collectively the 'Determinations') are being reviewed.

The Law Society's position is that the *Legal Profession (Non-contentious Probate Costs)* Determination 2021 and the *Legal Profession (Solicitors Costs)* Determination should be consolidated and simplified.

As Notorial practice is quite different from legal practice and notaries are appointed under and governed by a separate Act, that Determination should be kept separate.

In relation to the *Legal Profession (Solicitors Costs) Determination 2021*, the Law Society's position is that any increase consistent with CPI should be applied.
