Any application for Ordinary membership (by a person who holds an Australian Practising Certificate) or ILP membership must be accompanied by:

a) a completed "Professional Standards Scheme Participant Information" form OR

b) in the case of a person seeking exemption, subject to s30(4) of the *Professional Standards Act 1997*, an Application for Exemption from participation in the Scheme.
