


100 YEAR MILESTONE

December 2023 marks the 100 years since women won legislative change, removing barriers for women to be admitted and to practise law in Western Australia. This significant milestone would not have been possible without the courageous work of pioneering women who have gone before including Edith Cowan, as Western Australia's first female parliamentarian who led this legislative change on 22 December 1923.

In celebration of the 100 years anniversary in 2023, the Law Society held a special Long Table Lunch Law event and also launched the #100women100years campaign. This campaign creates a visual mosaic of the many faces of women in the law today with over 100 photos released to date and counting. These photos will appear on the Law Society's new website. 

